WHERE YOUR MONEY GOES...

ONE-OFF GRANTS

Mr and Mrs Brown were self-employed newsagents for 12 years. They contacted us because they were only just managing to keep up with their bills, following the closure of their shop at the beginning of the year.

Their cooker had recently broken and they had no savings to replace it.

NewstrAid were able to fund the replacement of their cooker and offer financial help and advice through the Fresh Start Assist scheme.

ANXIETY SUPPORT

Newsagent Mrs Smith contacted NewstrAid via our website after she read about us in the NFRN magazine.

She had endured an attempted armed robbery whilst alone in her shop and although she managed to foil the robbery, the long term effects had taken their toll and she was now suffering from post-traumatic stress disorder and felt very unsafe in the shop and, at times, in her own home. In addition, her family had accumulated a large amount of debt and were having to find alternative living accommodation due to their landlord selling the house they were renting.

Her most immediate need was assistance with counselling, indeed her words were 'I just need someone to talk to'.

NewstrAid was able to organise a wellbeing assessment for her through Anxiety UK and a further 6 therapy sessions to help her deal with the trauma she had gone though.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT AND ACE CHILDREN'S GRANT

Mr James was suffering from non-curable lung cancer and had not been able to work in his shop for some time. Once he ceased trading completely he and his family were left with very little to meet their living costs. They were facing a significant mortgage repayment each month and had two 14 year old boys to support.

NewstrAid was able to award the family 2 months' mortgage repayments from the Fresh Start Assist Scheme, and a further £500 from the ACE Children's Fund for back to school costs. In addition they were given an ongoing regular benefit payment to help during Mr James' illness.

FUNDRAISING SPOTLIGHT

Congratulations and a huge thank you to a team from the East Midlands Area Committee who successfully tackled the iconic National Three Peaks Challenge in June this year raising thousands of pounds for NewstrAid.

This gruelling mental and physical endurance race involved climbing the highest peaks in Scotland, England and Wales - Ben Nevis, Scafell Pike and Snowdon - within 24 hours.

Seven of the 11 people who started out on the challenge managed to complete it within the timeframe which is an extraordinary feat considering only around 40 per cent of those who tackle the challenge manage it in less than a day. Despite atrocious weather forecasts, conditions were favourable although a storm on Ben Nevis made walking extremely treacherous (two other walkers in the area were struck by lightning that day and one was unfortunately killed).

Collectively, the team raised **£6,000** for NewstrAid for which we are extremely grateful.
