The 3 Peaks BIG WALK

16th & 17th September 2023

What you need to know...

The walk will take place on the weekend of 16th and 17th September 2023.

The **Yorkshire Three Peaks Challenge** is a 24-mile (38.6km) round trip route and includes 1585m (5200ft) of ascent.

- The Challenge takes on the peaks of **Pen-y-Ghent** (694 metres), **Whernside** (736 metres) and **Ingleborough** (723 metres), usually in this order, and in under 12 hours. These hills form part of the Pennine range and encircle the head of the valley of the River Ribble, in the Yorkshire Dales National Park.
- The website below provides most of the information you will require. It provides advice on training, the kit you'll need and the accommodation options as it's unlikely that you will want to drive home after the walk. In fact, the NewstrAid team are staying for 2 nights: arriving on the 15th September, undertaking the challenge on the 16th and departing on the 17th.
